TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS DUE COVID-19

Dear Guests,

The following travel restrictions have been imposed by the following governments in response to the COVID-19 outbreak:

- Malaysian Government -

ALL Foreign Nationals are restricted from entering Malaysia effective from midnight Wed 18th March 2020, until Tues 31st March 2020

Only Malaysian Nationals returning home, or Foreign Nationals with “Fly Thru” tickets on AirAsia to onward destinations will be accepted for travel ex Australia.

Foreign Nationals booked only to Kuala Lumpur, or with onward connection on other airlines, will be denied travel as you will not be permitted to enter Malaysia.

- Indian Government -

ALL passengers travelling to India will be denied travel effective immediately

Flights leaving Malaysia will not be accepted into India, effective 1500 Indian time 17th March 2020 until 31st March 2020.

- Australian Government -

ALL non-Australian citizens and non-residents are restricted from entering Australia effective 2100 AEDST Friday 20th March 2020

Australian citizens, permanent residents and their immediate family (legal guardians, spouse, de facto partner, provisional partner visa holders and dependent children of a traveller eligible for entry into Australia).

New Zealanders ordinarily resident in Australia (444 visa) and New Zealanders transiting Australia to New Zealand.

All travellers, regardless of where you have flown from, must self-isolate for 14 days on arrival into Australia.
